AGM PECOSA 28.10.2025: Minutes of Meeting

The AGM started with the welcome address to the members by the Hony. President, Er Manish Gupta, highlighted the various initiatives taken by the PECOSA EC team over the last one year. Er Rajesh Kanda, Dean Alumni Affairs, informed the house that Director PEC Sh. Rajesh Bhatia is suddenly disposed and cannot join, and in his stead Er Rajesh Kanda welcomed the members and thanked the alumni for their support to PEC and also appreciated the role played by PECOSA in bridging the gap between alumni and PEC.

Upon crossing the necessary quorum of 70 members, the Hony. Secretary, Er Harpreet Singh Oberoi, presented the agenda before the house for approval, which was passed by the majority with the show of hands and thereafter, the previous year's minutes were put forth before the house, which were also passed by the majority with the show of hands.

Some members asked about the status of the amendment to the constitution of PECOSA, Hony Secretary, explained that further amendment is being proposed in the constitution as of now and request Hony Treasurer Jorawer Singh to take over the proceedings for presentation of the accounts and budget and to also specifically answer queries related to amendment to the constitution

Hony. Treasurer Jorawer Singh, requested the permission of the chair, to allow him to present the accounts for the year 2024-25, budget for 2025-26 and also to explain regarding the amendment to the constitution of PECOSA.

Hony. Treasurer placed before the house, the audited balance sheet for the year 2024-2025 for passing, Balance Sheet was made available in advance, online at the PECOSA website in the downloads section. Treasurer explained that there was some erroneous transfer by the bank of Rs 2,32,928/- being shown in Recoverable from Bank, and the same was recovered and credited back to our account in April 2025 itself. He further explained that PECOSA was able to add 2,34,391 as "excess of income over expenditure" to the assets of PECOSA. Further it was explained that the membership of new passing out students from PEC, is currently being paid from the Corpus of PECOSA, and since the MOU has already been signed with PEC, as and when the same shall be received from PEC, that amount will be credited back to PECOSA Corpus.

Further presented the budget for the year 2025-26, Hony Treasurer explained that out of the total proposed budget of 6,91,332/-, most of the expenses remain the same as before. It was further explained that website expenses shall be nil this year onwards, since PECOSA and tied with Almazines network to manage the alumni data and also to issue newsletters to alumni for better communication and visibility, further it was proposed that PECOSA has been compelled to hire a full time staff at its office, and for this proposed an additional budget of staff salary of 1,50,000/- (@ 15000/- per month). It was further explained that the Court case instituted by Er Mohit Srivastav is still sub judice, and since he had also made PEC and Deans as party to this litigation, PEC had informed PECOSA that it shall no longer be providing it's data for use of PECOSA. Fortunately with the intervention of a few senior distinguished alumni, MOU was signed with Almazine, which has offered to manage PECOSA

website and its database free of charge, provide a staff be provided, the handle and support registration and updating of member data on the website.

Further, almazine has signed a non-disclosure agreement, whereby, they shall ensure full compliance of THE DIGITAL PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT, 2023 (NO. 22 OF 2023), and that the data shall not be accessible by any member of PECOSA. Any communication to be made to members shall be done remotely from the backend, so as to ensure that the mobile numbers and email ids of the members are not visible to or accessible by anyone and are fully protected from the spam.

Hony. Treasurer also explained that since all the clauses in the constitution which shall be in conflict with the new enactment on Personal Digital Data Protection Act, are anyways void to that extent, and have already been taken care of, during the proposed amendments in AGMs of year 2017 & 2024, and that no amendment is therefore sought in the constitution.

The house was explained that PECOSA shall remain fully complied with protection of the digital data, and shall not display, or make it public on any website or online platform, from which any person can steal it, directly or by exploiting the source code, and may cause spamming, hacking or cyber fraud with our members.

The same issue was also highlighted during the last AGM that, the Act prescribes a stringent conditions of handling personal data, and that this data cannot be just made freely available online for public. It was proposed that since PECOSA do not currently has the funds to maintain, handle and keep secure the data of alumni, and since after the litigation by Er Mohit Srivastva, the current arrangement of maintaining the same with Punjab Engineering College has also been revoked, therefore, the necessary MOU has been now been made with Almazines.

The balance sheet for the year 2024-2025, the budget for the year 2025-26 and the above proposals were passed with the two third majority votes by raise of hands.

The proceedings were passed on to General Secretary Er HS Oberoi, who concluded the AGM with the vote of thanks, and wishing the new Executive Committee all the best.
